

RESOLUTION NO. R-74- 541

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-89 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 27 June 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 27th day of June, 1974, that petition No. 74-89, the petition of MARSHALL B. WOOD, TRUSTEE for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of the East 590 feet of the West 650 feet of the North 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 17, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, less the North 40 feet and South 30 feet thereof. Said property located on the east side of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807) approximately one (1) mile south of Forest Hill Boulevard, was approved as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Johnson, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lytal, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


