

RESOLUTION NO. R-74- 961

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-148 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 31 October 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 31 day of October, 1974, that petition No. 74-148, the petition of THOMAS J. WHITE by Samuel Ogren, Jr., Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW AN INTERIUM SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT on Tract H, Plat No. 3, Westroads Business and Industrial Park in Section 36, Township 42 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 30, pages 145 and 146, less the West 218.42 thereof. Said property located on the north side of Westroads Drive approximately 1/2 mile east of Military Trail (S.R. 809) in an IL-Light Industrial District, was approved as advertised.
