

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-165 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 31 October 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 31 day of October, 1974, that petition No. 74-165, the petition of LaVANCE G. MURO AND G. THURMAN FULMER for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of Lot 4, Morrison Suburban Development, in Section 5, Township 44 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 20, page 40, as depicted on that survey prepared by O'Brien, Suiter & O'Brien, Inc., Order No. 74-539-d, dated August 29, 1974, and on file at the Office of the Director of Planning, Zoning and Building. Said property located on the east side of Congress Avenue (S.R. S-807) approximately .3 mile north of Summit Boulevard, was approved as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Lytal, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

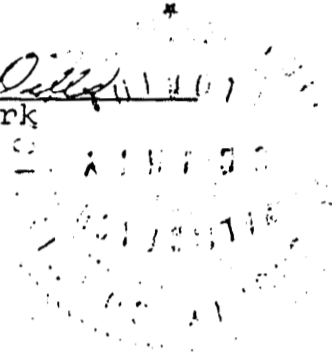
