

RESOLUTION NO. R-74- 1003

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-170 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 21 November 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 21 day of November, 1974, that petition No. 74-170, the petition of JOHN L. FRYSSINGER for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT of Tracts 88 and 109 through 112 inclusive, Block 78, and Tract 101, Block 79, together with that portion of the former, now abandoned road right-of-way, lying and being within 15 feet Northerly of, as measured at right angles to, the North line of said Tract 88, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Sections 19, 20, 29 and 30, Township 47 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, pages 45 through 54. Said property located approximately 3/4 mile east of State Road No. 7, immediately north of L.W.D.D. Lateral Canal No. 43, was approved as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Lytal,

Medlen , and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


