

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-414

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-62 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 May 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 29 day of May, 1975, that petition No. 75-62, the petition of BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, by E.W. "Bud" Weaver, Chairman for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of the South 100 feet of Government Lot 4, lying East of State Road A-1-A in Section 21, Township 46 South, Range 43 East; and the North 150 feet of Section, 28, Township 46 South, Range 43 East Lying between the Easterly right-of-way of State Road A-1-A and the Atlantic Ocean; and the South 100 feet of the North 250 feet of said Section 28, lying between the Easterly right-of-way of State Road A-1-A and the Atlantic Ocean; and the

South 100 feet of the North 570 feet of said Section 28, lying between the Easterly right-of-way of State Road A-1-A and the Atlantic Ocean; and also including the South 200 feet of the North 770 feet of said Section 28, lying between the Easterly right-of-way of State Road A-1-A and the Atlantic Ocean. Said property located on the east side of State Road A-1-A at the intersection with the extension of Southwest 12th Street, was approved as advertised.

Commissioner Medlen, moved for approval of the petition.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Johnson, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
