

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-699

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-118 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 September 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of September, 1975, that petition No. 75-118, the petition of FRANK J. MCCARTY AND DONALD N. NOEL for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of Lot 28, Square Lake, in Section 24, Township 42 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 23, page 141. Said property located on the west side of Military Trail (S.R. 809) approximately .6 mile south of Lake Park West Road (S.R. 809A), was denied as advertised.
