

RESOLUTION NO. R-75- 858

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-143 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 20 November 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 20th day of November, 1975, that petition No. 75-143, the petition of RAY F. FLOW for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE EXPANSION OF A CHILD CARE CENTER on the South 100 feet of the North 634 feet of the East 119.18 feet of the North 1/2 of Tract 16, Subdivision of Section 19, Township 44 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 6, page 66. Said property located on the east side of Ford Street approximately 600 feet north of 10th Avenue North in an RM-Residential Multiple Family District (Medium Density), was approved as advertised.
