

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-861

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-150 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 20 November 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 20th day of November, 1975, that petition No. 75-150, the petition of SANTO BUCCAFUSCHI for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE EXPANSION OF A DAY CARE CENTER on Lot 4, Block 1, Bermuda Park Addition No. 1 in Section 17, Township 44 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 21, page 50. Said property located on the east side of Congress Avenue (S.R. S-807) approximately .4 mile south of Forest Hill Boulevard in an RS-Residential Single Family District, was approved as advertised, subject to the following special condition:

1. Turnouts onto Congress Avenue shall be reconstructed so as to create a slip-in, slip-out effect. Said turnouts shall be approved by the County Engineer prior to the issuance of a building permit.
