

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-862

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, **is** authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided **for** in Chapter 402.5 **of** the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance **No.** 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-157 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 20 November 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 20th day of November, 1975, that petition No. 75-157, the petition of SANTO BUCCAFUSCHI to delete the following Special Condition placed on Zoning Petition No. 73-155:

Prior to the issuance of any building permits the developer shall dedicate to Palm Beach County, the additional right-of-way to provide for a one hundred twenty (120) foot right-of-way for Congress Avenue and the forty (40) feet for a limited access road, was approved as advertised.
