RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-15 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 24 February 1977

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 24th day of February, 1977, that petition No. 77-15 the petition of RALPH A. AND FLORENCE I. VALLIERE by Arthur A. Azzaro, Jr., Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT of the South 1/2 of the North 1/2 of Tract 12, of the Subdivision of the Southwest Quarter of Section 36, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 3, Page 10, Less the West 25 feet thereof, and subject to road right-of-way along the East 10 feet thereof; containing 2.65 acres more or less. Said property located on the east side of DeSoto Road, approximately .1 mile north of Lantana West Road (S.R. 812), was approved as advertised.
