RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-32 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 24 March 1977

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 24th day of March, 1977, that petition No. 77-32 the petition of UNITED TECHNOLOGIES CORPORATION, PRATT & WHITNEY AIRCRAFT GROUP, GOVERNMENT PRODUCTS DIVISION by William C. Missimer, Division Counsel for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A DEVELOPMENT FLIGHT TESTING OF HELICOPTERS AT THE FLIGHT TEST CENTER on a parcel of land situate in a part of Sections 14 and 15, Township 41 South, Range 40 East, more particularly described as: Commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 15, thence Northerly along the Easterly line of Section 15, 2,212.70 feet to the existing centerline of the main service road; thence East (an assumed bearing and all other bearings relative thereto) along the centerline of the main service road 200.0 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence North 700.00 feet; thence East 1100 feet; thence North 600.0 feet; thence West 2580.0 feet; thence South 800.0 feet; thence East 900.0 feet; thence

South 500.0 feet to the centerline of the main service road; thence East along the centerline of the main service road 580.0 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Said property located southwesterly of Bee Line Highway within the confines of the Pratt E Whitney Aircraft property in an IG-General Industrial District, was approved as advertised;
