RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-55 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 May 1977

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day of May, 1977, that petition No. 77-55 the petition of FOUR H SALES CO. by Dwight R. Weyant, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT of that part of Tracts 10 & 11 lying Southerly and Easterly of the F.E.C. Co. R.R. right-of-way and that part of Tract 9 lying Southerly and Easterly of the F.E.C. Co. Main right-of-way and West of the F.E.C. Co. spur right-of-way, all in the Subdivision of Section 20, Township 42 South, Range 37 East, as recorded in Plat Book 7, page 2. Said property located on the north side of 97th Place North approximately 245 feet west of S.R. 15, was approved as advertised.
