RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-70 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23 June 1977

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 23rd day of June, 1977, that petition No. 77-70 the petition of WILLIAM VERGIS for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW AN EXOTIC KENNEL on the North 1/2 of Tract 31, Block D, Loxahatchee Groves, in Section 17, Township 43 South, Range 41 East, as recorded in Plat Book 12, page 29. Said property located on the west side of "E" Road, approximately .3 mile south of North Road in an AG-Agricultural District, was denied as advertised.

Commissioner Medlen, moved for denial of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Evatt, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

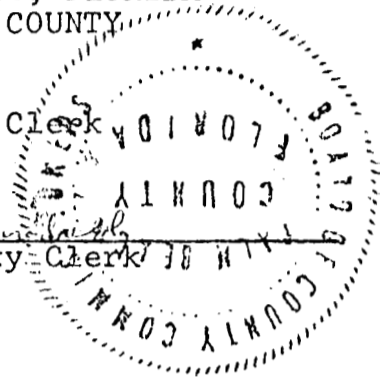
