RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the **authority** vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance **No. 73-2** have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-80 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on **28 July 1977**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of July, 1977, that petition No. 77-80 the petition of **ROBERT C. CARLSON** for the **REZONING, FROM RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT** of Lot **1**, Block **9**, Less the East 10 feet **for right-of-way for Congress Avenue, Frost Park** Subdivision in Section **18**, Township **44** South, Range **43** East, as recorded in Plat Book **23**, page **188**. Said property located on the northwest corner at the intersection of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807) and Frost Road, was approved as advertised.
