

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-125 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 September 1977.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of October, 1977, that petition No, 77-125 the petition of ANDREW L. HERSEY for a SPECIAL EX-CEPTION TO ALLOW A CUSTOM AUTO PAINT AND BODY SHOP on Lots 62, 63, 64, 65 and 66, Henry's Military Trail Addition, in Section 36, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 21, page 39. Said property located approximately 600 feet north of Southern Boulevard on the east side of Lindy Lane in a CG-General Commercial District, was denied as advertised.
