

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No, 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No, 77-97 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 September 1977.

NOW, THEREFORE, RE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of October, 1977, that petition No. 77-97 the petition of FRANK L. DIETZ AND RAYMOND L. WORKMAN for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, of the North 140 feet of the West 662 feet of the Northwest 1/4 of th'e Northwest 1/4 of Section 13, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, less the right-of-way of State Road 809 (Military Trail) and less the right-of-way of L.W.D.D. Lateral Canal No. 32, together with the South 15 feet of the North 55 feet of the North 140 feet of the West 662 feet of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 13, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, Said property located on the east side of Military Trail (S.R. 809), approximately 3/4 mile north of Delray West Road, was approved as advertised.
