

RESOLUTION NO. R-78-224

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-12 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 January 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 26th day of January, 1978, that petition No. 78-12 the petition of ELSIE RATTERSHALL, by Joel Wantman, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT of Tract 43, Block 22, Palm Beach Farms Company, Plat No. 3, in Section 22, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Pages 45 through 54, inclusive, Less however, the Northerly 52 feet thereof. Said property located on the west side of Wry Road, approximately .3 mile north of Lake Worth Road (S.R.802), was approved as advertised.
