

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-68 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 30 May 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 30th day of May, 1978, that petition No. 78-68 the petition of DONALD FLEURY, ERNEST FLEURY and WAYNE G. FLEURY by Wayne G. Fleury, Agent, for the REZONING FROM RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT AND THE FURTHER SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PLANNED INDUSTRIAL PARK DEVELOPMENT INCLUDING A HEAVY EQUIPMENT SALES AND SERVICE FACILITY on the East 301.88 feet of Lot 5, less the South 17 feet thereof, of Adams Subdivision, in Section 1, Township 43 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 20, page 23. Said property located on the north side of 45th Street (S.R. 702), approximately .3 mile east of Haverhill Road, was denied as advertised.
