

RESOLUTION NO. R-78- 708

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-91 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 May 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 25th day of May, 1978, that petition No. 78-91 the petition of E. P. GIULIANO for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RT-RESIDENTIAL TRANSITIONAL DISTRICT of the East 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 30, Township 46 South, Range 43 East, lying south of Germantown Road, subject to easements and rights-of-way of record. Said property located on the south side of Germantown Road, approximately 600 feet west of the L.W.D.D. Equalizing Canal No. E-4, was approved as advertised.
