

RESOLUTION NO. R-78-986

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-157 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 27 July 1978,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 27th day of July, 1978, that petition No. 78-157 the petition of H.A.S. LAND DEVELOPMENT INC. by J.D. Sheets, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT, of Tract 8 and the North 1/2 of Tract 9, Less the West 410 feet thereof, together with the South 1/2 of Tract 9, also together with all of Tracts 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, and 41, Block 80, of Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, in Section 29, Township 47 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 53. Said property located on the east side of 90th Avenue South, approximately 1 mile east of S.R. 7, was approved as advertised.

Commissioner Medlen, moved for approval of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Koehler, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


