

RESOLUTION NO. R-78- 1117

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-167 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 24 August 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 24th day of August, 1978, that petition No. 78-167 the petition of E. P. GIULIANO for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RT-RESIDENTIAL TRANSITIONAL DISTRICT of the East 1182 feet of the West 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 25, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, lying South of the South right-of-way of Germantown Road. Subject to easements and rights-of-way of record. Said property located on the south side of Germantown Road, approximately .5 mile east of Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as advertised.
