

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, **as** the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided **for** in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No, 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-194 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 24 August 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA**, assembled in regular session the 24th day of August, 1978, that petition No, 78-194 the petition of MICHAEL HERBERT for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE EXPANSION OF AN EXISTING DAY CARE CENTER on Lot 3, Drew Manor, in Section 18, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 21, page 36. Said property located on the northwest corner of the intersection of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807) and Drew Way in an RS-Residential Single Family District, **was** approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

1. Petitioner shall pave Drew Way **from** Congress Avenue to the west property line.
2. The maximum additional enrollment **shall** not exceed twenty-five (25) children.
