

RESOLUTION NO. R-78-1137

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-144 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 24 August 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session on the 24th day of August, 1978, that petition No. 78-144 the petition of CHARLES E. GAINES for the REZONING, FROM RH-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY) TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, of the East 160 feet of the North 544.5 feet of the East 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 3, Township 41 South, Range 42 East. Said property located on the south side of Indiantown Road (West Ocean Boulevard), approximately 2.5 miles east of Dixie Highway, was approved as advertised.
