

RESOLUTION NO. R-78- 1141

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-182 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 24 August 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 24th day of August, 1978, that petition No. 78-182 the petition of WILLIAM J. FENNESSY by David A. Sapp, Attorney, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW COMMERCIAL STABLES AND WATER TREATMENT FACILITY on that portion of the South 1/2 of the North 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 10, Township 47 South, Range 41 East, lying Southeast of the Central and Southern Florida Flood Control District Southeasterly right-of-way line of Levee L-40, less the North 446.54 feet thereof and less rights-of-way of record; together with that portion of the North 1/2 of the South 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 10, Township 47 South, Range 41 East, lying Southeast of the Central and Southern Flood Control District Southeasterly right-of-way line of Levee L-40, less the South 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of said Section 10. Said property located on the west side of 120th Avenue South, approximately 2.5 miles west of S.R. 7 (U.S. 441) in an AG-Agricultural District, was denied as advertised.
