

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes,, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-229 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 30 November 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 30th day of November, 1978, that petition No. 78-229 the petition of MARGUERITE K. SPEIER for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RT-RESIDENTIAL TRANSITIONAL DISTRICT of the East 1/2 of the East 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 35, Township 44 South, Range 42 East; Subject to road right-of-way over the East 10 feet and the South 25 feet thereof, Subject to canal right-of-way over the North 75 feet thereof. Said property located on the northwest-corner of the intersection of Nash Trail and Myers Road, was approved as amended per the petitioner's request for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT.
