

RESOLUTION NO. R-79-101

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements' as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No, 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-260 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 December 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 28th day of December, 1978, that petition No. 78-260 the petition of RICHARD J. MENIN, TRUSTEE, by Dwight R. Weyant, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT of the East 1/4 of Tracts 17, 18, 19 and 20, Model Land Co. in Section 14, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 5, page 78; subject to right-of-way for Purdy Lane and L.W.D.D. Lateral Canal No. 8; together with the West 1/2 of vacated road right-of-way adjoining East boundary. Said property located on the north side of Purdy Lane, approximately .7 mile west of Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as advertised.
