

RESOLUTION NO. R-79- 198

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No, 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 79-29 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 January 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 25th day of January, 1979, that petition No. 79-29 the petition of JUDITH B. SOVEREL for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT of a parcel of land in Section 11, Township 41 South, Range 41 East, more particularly described as follows: the North 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 11; subject to a road easement over the Westerly 30 feet thereof. Said property located on the east side of Haynie Lane, approximately .1 mile west of 115th Avenue North, was approved as advertised.
