RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 79-6 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 22 February 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 22d day of February, 1979, that petition No. 79-6 the petition of BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, by Peggy Evatt, Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of the East 100 feet of the North 1/2 of Tract 5, Block 4, Plat No. 1, Palm Beach Plantations, in Section 12, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 10, page 20. Said property located on the south side of Forest Hill Boulevard, approximately 1/4 mile west of Kirk Road, was approved as advertised.
