

RESOLUTION NO. R-79-1238

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 79-166 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23 August 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 23^d day of August, 1979, that petition No. 79-166 the petition of F. RONALD MASTRIANA, ESQUIRE, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT of Lots 105, 106, 107, 108, Block 78, of Palm Beach Farms Plat No. 3 in Section 19, Township 47 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 53. Said property located on the north side of Pondwood Road, approximately .5 mile east of State Road No. 7, was approved as advertised.


Commissioner Gregory, moved for approval of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Foster, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
