

RESOLUTION NO. R-79- 1241

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No, 79-170 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23 August 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 23^d day of August, 1979, that petition No. 79-170 the petition of NORMAN S. KENNET for the REZONING, FROM RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of the East 80 feet of the West 200 feet of the East 800 feet of the North 208 feet of Tract 5, Block 4, Section 12, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, PALM BEACH PLANTATIONS, as recorded in Plat Book 10, page 20. Said property located on the south side of Forest Hill Boulevard, approximately .1 mile east of the intersection of Forest Hill Boulevard and Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as advertised.
