

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 24th day of April, 1980, that Petition No. 80-66 the petition of JOHN C. MILLS by Alan J. Ciklin, Attorney, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 1, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, LESS, however, the North 495.0 feet and the East 159.83 feet thereof, as measured at right angles to the boundary lines of the said Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 and less the right-of-way for Coconut Road and Military Trail (S.R. 809); TOGETHER WITH a part of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 1, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, more particularly described as the South 330 feet of the North 495 feet of said Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 1, except that part lying in Military Trail (being State Road No. 809) and also except the Easterly 159.83 feet of the South 50 feet thereof. Said property located on the northeast corner of the intersection of Military Trail (S.R. 809) and Coconut Road, was approved as advertised.
