RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body,, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of 'the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. ~~81-75~~ was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 May 1981; and

North 280 feet of the West 297 feet of the East 350 feet, in Section 36, Township 43 South, Range 42 East. Said property located on the west side of Military Trail (S.R. 809), approximately .4 mile south of Belvedere Road, was approved as advertised.

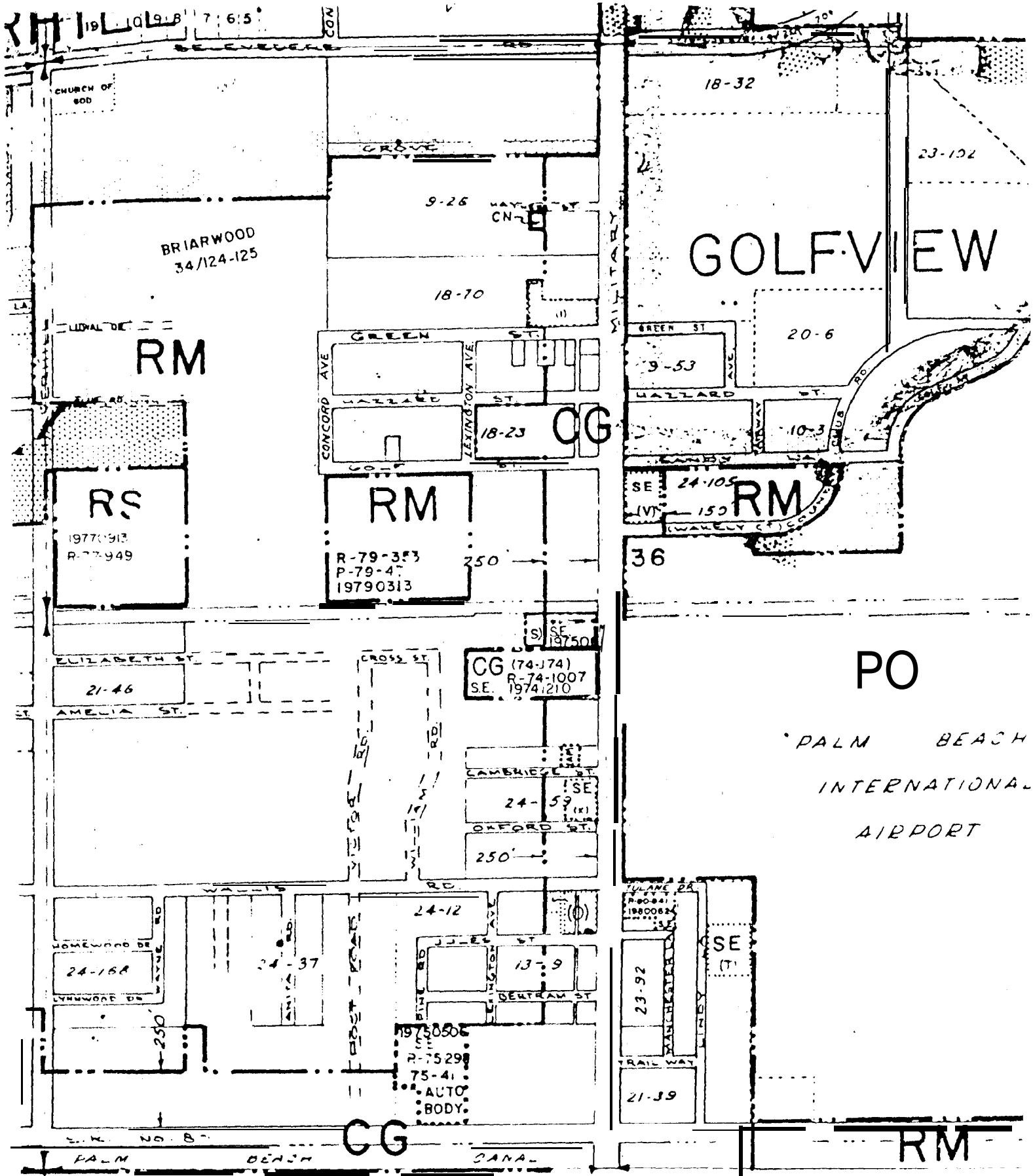

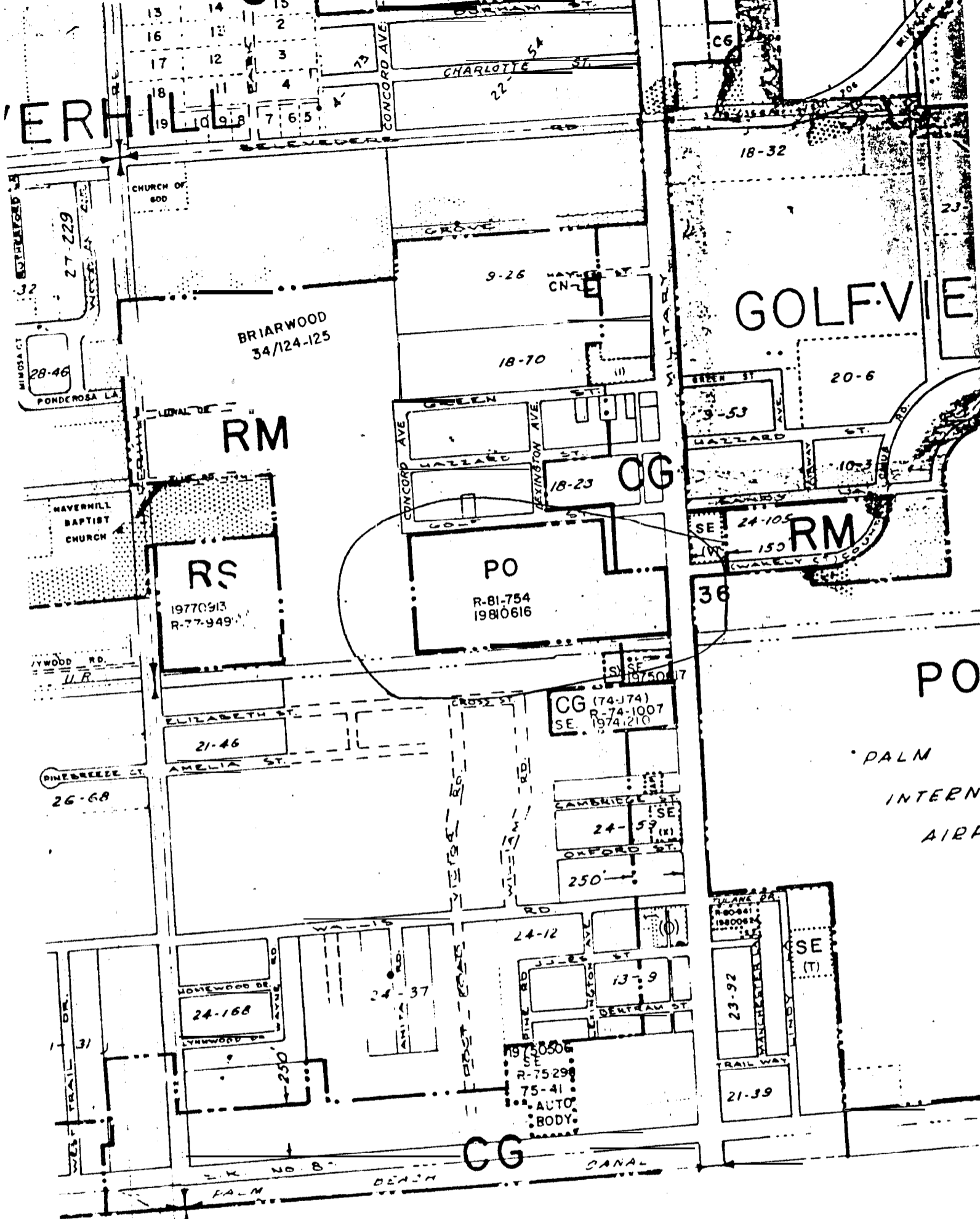
