

RESOLUTION NO. R-82-394

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 82-19 Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 82-19 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 February 1982; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. The proposal would be in harmony and compatible with the present and future development of the area concerned

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of February 1982, that Petition No. 82-19 the petition of ROSCOE M. THORNE for the REZONING, FROM RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of Lot 'C', Block 128, Palm Beach Farms

co. Plat No. 7, in Section 30, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 5, page 72. Said property located on the west side of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807), approximately .2 mile south of Melaleuca Lane, was approved as advertised.
