

RESOLUTION NO. R-84-61

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 83-104, Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREFIS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 83-104 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29th September 1983; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. The proposed rezoning to CS is permitted under the "Commercial Potential" Comprehensive Plan designation.
2. A straight rezoning does not afford the County the opportunity to address serious traffic issues.,
3. This petition conforms to the Mandatory Performance Standard relating to water and sewer provisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 29th day September 1983, that Petition No. 83-104 the petition of FLORIDA REINVESTMENT CORPORATION By Abraham R. Golshani, President, for the REZONING, FROM RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT on Tract B, Westchester Townhouses in Section 24, Township 43 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 42, pages 187 through 188. Said property located on the east side of Military Trail (S.R. 809), approximately .7 miles north of Okeechobee Road (S. R. 704) was approved as advertised.
