RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION 83-103, Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code.

Said property located on the northeast corner of the intersect ion of Military Trail (S.R. 809) and Woodstock Drive, approximately .8 miles north of Okeechobee Road (S. R. 704) was denied.
