RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 83-171, Special Except ion

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 482.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code

Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petit ion No. 83-171 was presented, to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 22nd December 1383; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. The proposed special exception is consistent with the requirement of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BORRD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 22nd day December 1983, that Petition No. 83-171 the petition of G. AND G. ENTERPRISES AND EL-MOR REALTY, INC., By Beril Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW CHEMICAL STORRGE TANKS on the Southeast corner of Section 25, Township 47 South, Range 41 East, as surveyed by the State of Florida in May and June 1912 and as shown on the Right-of-Way Map of the Florida State Road Department in their survey of State Road No. 7 in February 1'341 as Project 5268; run (for convenience the South line of said Section 25 is assumed to bear North 28 degrees 54' 16" West and all other bearings mentioned herein are relative thereto) thence North 88 degrees 54'16" West along the South line of said Section 25 a distance of 148.58 feet to the Westerly right-of-way line of State Road No. 7; thence North along said right-of-way line a distance of 43.53 feet to an angle point; thence North O degrees 28'33" East

continuing along said right-of-way line a distance of 501.26 feet to a point in the North right-of-way line of Sandalfoot Boulevard as same is recorded in Official Record Book 1848, Page 1615, thence North 89 degrees 414'69" West along said right--of-way of Sandal foot Boulevard 99.00 feet; thence North 00 degrees 28'33" East 200.00 feet to the Point of Beginning and the Southeast corner- of the herein described parcel; thence continue North 00 degrees 28'33" East 294.43 feet; thence North 89 degrees 23'54" West 228.68 feet; thence South 00 degrees 28'33" West 293.17 feet; thence South 89 degrees 04'09" East 220.68 feet, more or less, to the Point of Beginning. Said property located on the west side of S. R. #7 (U.S. 441), approximately .7 mile south of Palmetto Park Road in an CG-General Commercial District was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The development shall retain onsite 85% of the stormwater runoff generated by a three (3) year storm per requirements of the Permit Section, Land Development Division.
- 2, The property owner shall reserve **for dedication** at no cost to Palm Beach County, **the** ultimate right-of-way for State Road 7, two hundred (200) feet west of the west right-of-way kine of the E-l Canal., Dedication **shall** be made. when requested to permit actual roadway widening.
- 3. Prior to site plan certification, the site plan shall be amended to provide a detail specifying the following:
- a) a concrete base enclosure for each tank connected to the property's sanitary sewer lines.
- b) steel or concrete posts to prevent vehicle collisions with. the tanks.
- c) a solid wood enclosure around the tanks to provide screening-from adjoining properties.
