

RESOLUTION NO. R-85-314

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 84-112(A), Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 84-112(A) was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on the 29th of November 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. The proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 29th of November 1984, that Petition No. 84-112(A) the petition of HAROLD D. AND FLORINE PREWITT By Lee Starkey, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT on the South 1/2 of Tract 118, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 1, in Section 18, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat 2, Pages 26 through 28. Said property located on the north side Delray West Road (S.R.806), approximately .3 mile east of U.S. 441 (S.R.7) was approved as advertised.
