NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 2nd of December 1985, that Petition No. 85-146 the petition of August Properties, Inc., By Doc J. Durden, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, INPART, AND RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY), INPART, TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT being the East 150 feet of the West 350 feet of the North 1/2 of the North 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 13, Township 44 South, Range 42 East; LESS the North 40 feet to Lake Worth Water Control District for road and drainage purposes. Subject to an easement for road purposes over the South 10 feet of the North 50 feet; thereof, together with an easement for road purposes over the South 10 feet of the North 50 feet of the East 200 feet. Said property located on the south side

of Canal 8 Road, approximately 150 feet east of Military Trail (S.R. 809) was denied with prejudice US advertisea.
