RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION 76-3(A): Special Exception

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHERERS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREFIS, Petition No. 76-3(A) was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its public hearing conducted on January 29, 1987; and

WHERERS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHERERS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is not consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BERCH COUNTY, FLORIDA that: Petition No. the 76-3(A), the petition of GERALD M. HIGIER, By F. Martin Perry, Attorney, for a SPECIQL EXCEPTION TO AMEND THE SITE PLAN FOR A PLANNED COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT PREVIOUSLY APPROVED UNDER ZONING PETITION 76-3 TO DELETE 7.39 RCRES on a parcel of land in Section 13, Township 45 South, Range 42 East, described as follows: Tract "B" as shown on the Plat of Le Chalet Shopping Center, as recorded in Plat Book 32, Page 23, Together with all lands in the Northwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 13, Township 45 South, Range 42 East, lying South of the South line of said Tract "B" and lying

West of the Westerly Right-of-way of Military Trail (SR 809), Together with that part of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of said Section 13, Lying Northerly and Westerly of the Westerly Right-Of-Way known as Old Military Trail (said road formerly known as SR 200 described and deeded to Palm Beach County in official Records Book 192, Pages 206 Through 208).
