

RESOLUTION NO. R-88 -131

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION S86-7
REVOKING A SPECIAL EXCEPTION FOR ZONING PETITION NO. 87-2
AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-82-414

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 462.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. S86-7 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its public hearing conducted on November 18, 1986 and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Petition No. S86-7 (Regarding Zoning Petition No. 82-7, Resolution No. R-82-414), The Petition of the Board of County Commissioners, by Karen T. Marcus, Chairman, to Revoke a Special Exception for a Planned Unit Development, on the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4, less the South 160 feet of the East 160 feet thereof; and the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4, less the South 160 feet thereof, and less the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 in Section 25, Township 43 South, Range 41 east, located approximately one-half mile west of State Road 7 and approximately 0.6 of a mile south of Okeechobee Road, was approved as advertised.

A motion to approve Petition No. S86-7 was offered by Commissioner Adams, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Owens, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
