

RESOLUTION NO. R-88-137

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION NO. S86-20
REVOKING A SPECIAL EXCEPTION FOR ZONING PETITION NO. 79-202
AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-79-1470

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. S86-20 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its public hearing conducted on November 18, 1986 and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Petition No. S86-20 (Regarding Zoning Petition No. 79-202, Resolution No. R-79-1470), The Petition of the Board of County Commissioners, to Revoke a Special Exception for a Commercial Kennel and a Commercial Stable with Accessory Buildings and Structures, on that part of the East 1/2 of Tract 8, Block 5, "THE PALM BEACH FARMS COMPANY PLAT NO. 3", in Section 27, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 46, lying Southerly for the right-of-way of LAKE WORTH DRAINAGE DISTRICT Lateral Canal No. 3, located on the south side of Belvedere Road, approximately 8.2 of a mile east of Florida's Turnpike, was approved as advertised.

A motion to approve Petition No. S86-20 was offered by Commissioner Owens, moved for approval of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Adams, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
