Marcus, Chairnan, for the Rezoning from CG-General Commercial Zoning District to RM-Multiple Family Residential Zoning District on the South 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4, less the Nest 53 feet for road right-of-way, in Section 12, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, located on the east side of Military Trail, approximately D.4 of a mile north of Forest Hill Boulevard, was withdrawn, without prejudice.
