RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION NO. 89-124 REZONING PETITION OF GRAND PRIX ASSOCIATES, LTD.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 89-124 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its public hearing conducted on November 30, 1989; and

1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations.

WHEREAS, 402.5 of the Zoning Code requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Petition No. 89-124, the petition of GRAND PRIX ASSOCIATES, LTD., BY WILLIAM B. BOOSE, AGENT, for a REZONING FROM AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE ZONING DISTRICT, IN PART, AND RT-RESIDENTIAL TRANSITIONAL ZONING DISTRICT, IN PART, on a parcel of land lying in the West 1/2 of Section 20, Township 44 South, Range 41 East and being located on the South side of Pierson Road, and is bounded on the West by the C-24 Canal, approximately 4.5 miles West of U.S. Highway 441 (SR 7), was approved on November 30, 1989, as advertised.
