RESOLUTION APPROVING RESTATUS REPORT NO.
TO AMEND CONDITIONS OF RESOLUTION NO. R-5



WHICH APPROVED THE SPECIAL EXCEPTION OF THOMAS DATORRE PETITION NO. 84-121

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, systematic monitoring and review of approved zoning actions help implement the goals and objectives ${f of}$ the Comprehensive Plan.

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Section 402.9 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 402.9, Status Report SR 84-121 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at a public hearing conducted on April 23, 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, has reviewed Status Report SR 84-121 and considered testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties, and the recommendations of the various county review agencies; and

WHEREAS, Section 402.9 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code authorizes the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, to add or modify conditions of approval; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, made the following findings of fact:

- 1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations; and
- 2. The **new** condition listed below requires this petition to develop more in conformity with current standards **of** development.

WHEREAS, Section 402.5 of the Zoning Code requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the recommendation of Status Report No. SR 84-121, amending Conditions of Approval of Resolution No. R-85-257, the Special Exception of Thomas Datorre, Petition No. 84-121, which granted a Special Exception approval to allow a Planned Residential Development, on the South 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 1, Townsnip 45 South, Range 42 East., being located on the east side of Military Trail, approximately 0.8 of a mile north of Hypoluxo Road, in a RM-Multiple Family Residential District (Medium Density) Zoning District, is approved, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The petitioner **shall** comply with all previous conditions **of** approval unless expressly modified herein.
- 2. By September 30, 1992, the property owner shall submit and have certified a site plan which complies to the

maximum extent possible with the landscape code in effect at that time.
