

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION Z2002-051  
OFFICIAL ZONING MAP AMENDMENT (REZONING)  
WITH A CONDITIONAL OVERLAY ZONE (COZ)  
PETITION OF RENE & GINA TERCILLA  
BY RENE & GINA TERCILLA, AGENT  
(TERCILLA REZONING)

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body of Palm Beach County, Florida, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements, as provided for in Article 5 (Development Review Procedures) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code (Ordinance 92-20), have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Zoning Petition 22002-051 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners at a public hearing conducted on January 9, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the petitioner and other interested parties, the recommendations of the various county review agencies, and the recommendation of the Zoning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) is consistent with the Palm Beach County Comprehensive Plan;
2. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) is consistent with the requirements of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code;
3. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) with approved conditions is compatible with surrounding uses and zones, as defined in the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code, is generally consistent with existing uses and zones surrounding the subject land, and is the appropriate zoning district for the land;
4. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) with approved conditions does not result in significantly adverse impacts on the natural environment, including but not limited to water, air, stormwater management, wildlife, vegetation, wetlands, and the natural functioning of the environment;
5. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) with approved conditions will result in a logical and orderly development pattern;
6. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) complies with Article 11, (Adequate Public Facilities) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code, Ordinance 92-20, as amended; and,
7. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) is consistent with the requirements of all other applicable local land development regulations.

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 5.3.D.9 (Action by Board of County Commissioners) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Zoning Petition Z2002-051, the petition of Rene & Gina Tercilla by Rene & Gina Tercilla, agent, for an Official Zoning Map Amendment rezoning from the Agricultural Residential Zoning District to the Residential Transitional Zoning District with a Conditional Overlay Zone on a parcel of land legally described in EXHIBIT A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, and generally located as indicated on a vicinity sketch attached as EXHIBIT B, attached hereto and made a part hereof, was approved on January 9, 2003, subject to the conditions of the Conditional Overlay Zone described in EXHIBIT C, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Commissioner Masilotti moved for the approval of the Resolution.

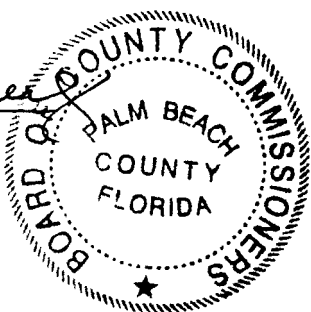
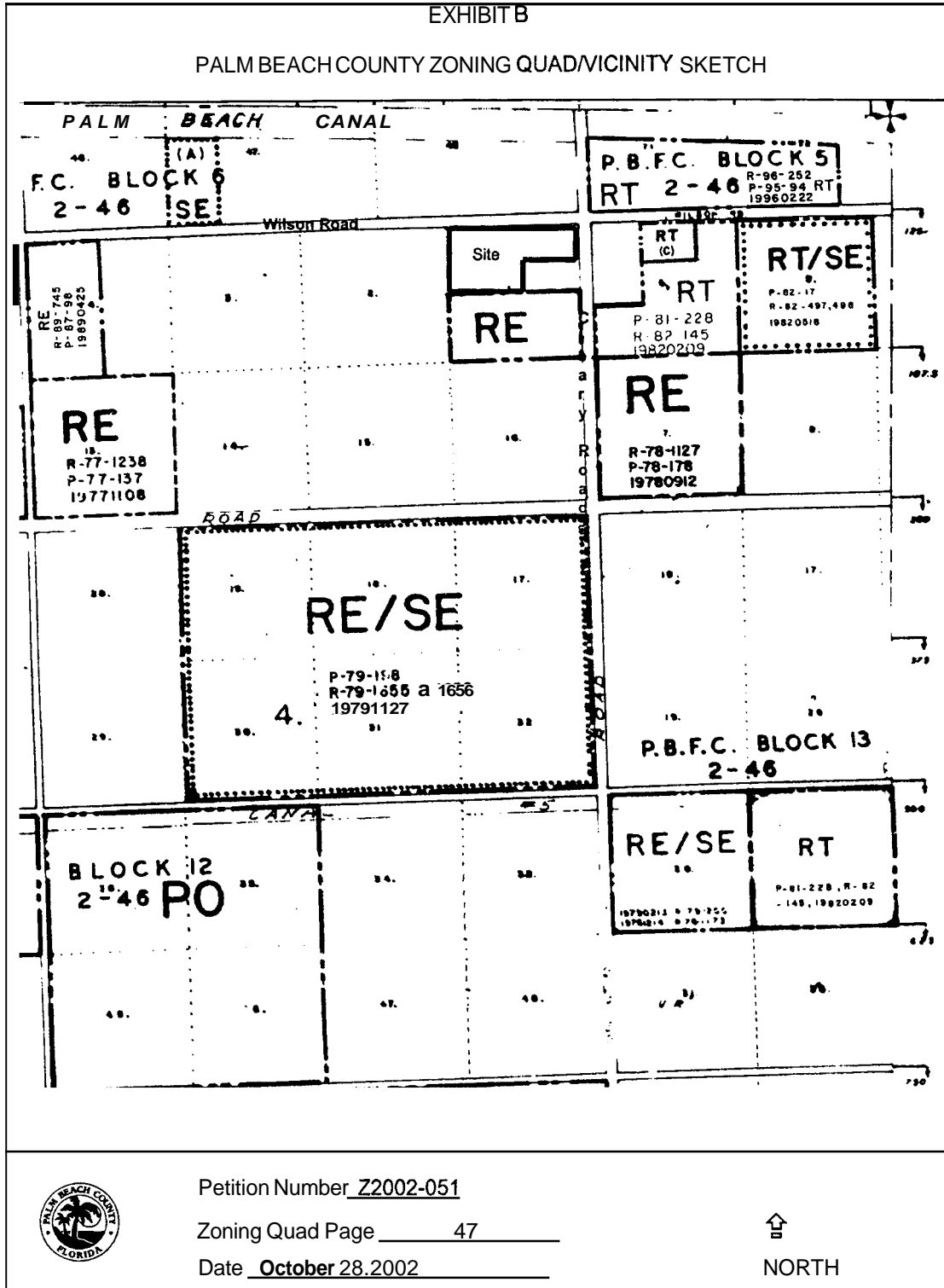


EXHIBIT A  
LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The north ½ of Tract 1, Block 12, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 45, Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida, less the South 166.5 feet of the East 232.80 feet of the North ½ of Tract 1, Block 12, and less the East 15 feet for road right of way.

## EXHIBIT C

### CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

#### A. ENVIRONMENTAL

1. All existing native vegetation depicted on the site plan to remain shall be maintained in perpetuity. Areas where existing native vegetation have been incorporated into the site plan shall be maintained free from invasive, exotic and non-native species. (ONGOING:ERM-Erm)

#### B. SCHOOL BOARD

1. The property owner shall post a notice of annual boundary school assignments for students from this development. A sign 1 1/2' X 17" shall be posted in a clear and visible location in all sales offices and models with the following:

#### "NOTICE TO HOME BUYERS/TENANTS"

School age children may not be assigned to the public school closest to their residences. School Board policies regarding levels of service or other boundary policy decisions affect school boundaries. Please contact the Palm Beach County School District Boundary Office at (561) 434-8100 for the most current school assignment(s). (ONGOING:SCHOOL BOARD-School Board)

There are no Conditions C & D.

#### E. ENGINEERING

1. Prior to the recordation of the plat or recordation of a plat waiver as determined by the County Engineer the property owner shall convey to Palm Beach County Land Development Division by road right-of-way warranty deed additional right of way for a twenty five foot "Corner Clip" at the Intersection of Cleary Road and Wilson Road. Property owner shall provide Palm Beach County with sufficient documentation acceptable to the Right of Way Acquisition Section to ensure that the property is free of all encumbrances and encroachments. (PLAT: ENGINEERING-Eng)
2. Prior to issuance of the next Building Permit the Developer shall plat or record a plat waiver as determined by the County Engineer for the subject property in accordance with provisions of Article 8 of the Unified Land Development Code. (BLDG PERMIT: MONITORING-Eng)

#### F. COMPLIANCE

1. In granting this approval, the Board of County Commissioners relied upon the oral and written representations of the petitioner both on the record and as part of the application process. Deviations from or violation of these representations shall cause the approval to be presented to the Board of County Commissioners for review under the compliance condition of this approval. (ONGOING: MONITORING - Zoning)
2. Failure to comply with any of the conditions of approval for the subject property at any time may result in:
  - a. The issuance of a stop work order; the issuance of a cease and desist order; the denial or revocation of a building permit; the denial or revocation of a Certificate of Occupancy; the denial of any other permit, license or approval to any developer, owner, lessee, or user of the subject property; the revocation of any other permit, license or approval from any developer, owner, lessee, or user of the subject property; revocation of any concurrency; and/or

- b. The revocation of the Official Map Amendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment, and/or any other zoning approval; and/or
- c. A requirement of the development to conform with the standards of the ULDC at the time of the finding of non-compliance, or the addition or modification of conditions reasonably related to the failure to comply with existing conditions; and/or
- d. Referral to code enforcement; and/or
- e. Imposition of entitlement density or intensity.

Staff may be directed by the Executive Director of PZ&B or a Code Enforcement Special Master to schedule a Status Report before the body which approved the Official Zoning Map Amendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment, and/or other zoning approval, in accordance with the provisions of Section 5.8 of the ULDC, in response to any flagrant violation and/or continued violation of any condition of approval.

Appeals of any departmental administrative actions hereunder may **be** taken to the Palm Beach County Board of Adjustment or as otherwise provided in the Unified Land Development Code (ULDC), as amended. Appeals of any revocation of an Official Zoning Map Amendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment or other actions based on a Board of County Commission decision shall be by petition for writ of certiorari to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit. (MONITORING)
