WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact

- 2. This Development Order Amendment complies with the relevant and appropriate portions of Article 6, Supplementary Use Standards, of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code.

- 4. This Development Order Amendment, with conditions as adopted, is compatible as defined in the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code and generally consistent with the uses and character of the land surrounding and in the vicinity of the land proposed for development.
