RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION R-98-16  
RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION OF THE SOUTHLAND CORP  
PETITION CA96-52(A)

WHEREAS, The Southland Corp., petitioned the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners on January 8, 1998 for Class A Conditional Use (CA) to allow a Convenience store with gas sales in the General Commercial (CG) Zoning District ; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-98-16, adopted on January 8, 1998 confirming the action of the Board of County Commissioners inadvertently contained an error in Exhibit C, Condition 13 (Lighting); and

WHEREAS, Exhibit C, Condition 13 of Resolution R-98-16 should have indicated below:

- 3. All outdoor lighting fixtures, excluding security lighting, shall be setback a minimum of ~~fifteen (15)~~ fourteen (14) feet from all residential property lines. (DRC: ZONING - Bld Permit)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
- 2. Exhibit C, Condition 13 of Resolution R-98-16 is hereby amended.


The Chair thereupon declared the resolution was duly passed and adopted on January 29, 1998.
