RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING APPLICATION OF
Land Passages, Inc., William Burckart
Jupiter Farms Community Shopping Center
APPLICATION DOA-2011-02905

WHEREAS, Land Passages, Inc., William Burckart, petitioned the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners on April 26, 2012 for a Development Order Amendment to reconfigure the Preliminary Site Plan, modify and delete Conditions of Approval (Use and Architectural Control), and expand an existing requested use; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-2012-0603, adopted on April 26, 2012 confirming the action of the Board of County Commissioners inadvertently contained an error in Exhibit C; and

WHEREAS, USE LIMITATIONS – DAYCARE CENTER Condition-1 of Exhibit C of Resolution R-2012-0603 should have read as shown as follows:

USE LIMITATIONS-DAYCARE CENTER

1. Condition J.1 of Resolution R-2005-144, Petition 1992-017E, which currently states:

The day care center shall be limited to a maximum of ninety-nine (99) children. (ONGOING: HEALTH – Health) (~~Previous Condition J.1 of Resolution R-2005-144, Petition 1992-017E~~)

Is hereby amended to read:

The daycare center shall be limited to a maximum of one hundred and ninety-nine (199) children. (ONGOING: HEALTH – Health)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
2. USE LIMITATIONS – DAYCARE CENTER Condition-1 of Exhibit C of Resolution R-2012-0603 is hereby corrected.

Commissioner Abrams moved for the approval of the Resolution.
