# RESOLUTION REVOKING RESOLUTION R-1974-331 (CONTROL NUMBER 1974-00027) AFFIRMING THE LEGISLATIVE ABANDONMENT OF ZONING APPLICATION ABN-2013-03103

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body of Palm Beach County, Florida, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapters 125 and 163, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions related to zoning;

WHEREAS, Zoning Application SE1974-027 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners at a public hearing on April 27, 1974;

WHEREAS, Resolution R-1974-331 approving this application was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on May 7, 1974;

WHEREAS, the Zoning Director presented the abandonment of the development order to the Board of County Commissioners for ratification on March 27, 2014;

WHEREAS, Article 2.A.1.K (Public Hearing Procedures) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code (ULDC) requires that action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Resolution R-1974-331, approving Zoning Application SE-1974-027, the petition of Coral Gables Federal Savings and Loan Association, by Bernard M. Kepshire, Vice President, agent, for a Special Exception to allow a Financial Institution is hereby revoked.

### LEGAL DESCRIPTION

### **Legal Description**

A portion of Lot 99, Block 81, PALM BEACH FRAMS COMPANY PLAT NO. 3, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 53 of the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the intersection of the centerline of Southwest 66<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the centerline of Southwest 14<sup>th</sup> Street, as shown on the Plat of SANDALFOOT COVE, SECTION ONE, as recorded in Plat Book 28, Pages 225 and 226 of the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida and run South 89°05′05″ West along the said centerline of Southwest 14<sup>th</sup> Street for 418.00 feet; thence run South 00°54′55″ East for 50.00 feet to a point on the south right-of- way line of said Southwest 14<sup>th</sup> Street and the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continue South 00°54′55″ East for 399.50 feet; thence run South 89°05′05″ West for 205.50 feet; thence run North 00°54′55″ West for 211.50 feet; thence run South 89°05′05″ West for 5.00 feet; thence run North 00°54′55″ West for 188.00 feet to a point lying on the south right of way line of said Southwest 14<sup>th</sup> Street; thence run North 89°05′05″ East for 210.50 feet along the south right-of- way line of said Southwest 14<sup>th</sup> Street to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
