RESOLUTION APPROVING RECOMMENDATION OF
STATUS REPORT NO. STR-2002-0052-1
TO REVOKE THE DEVELOPMENT ORDER AMENDMENT APPROVED BY
RESOLUTION NO. R-2008-1709
CONTROL NO. 2002-0052
APPLICATION NO. DOA/R-2008-00290

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC), as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code, as amended, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, systematic monitoring and review of approved zoning actions help implement the goals and objectives of the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Article 2.E. of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 2.E., Status Report STR-2002-0052-1 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at a public hearing conducted on April 26, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has reviewed Status Report STR-2002-0052-1 and considered testimony, and the recommendations of the various county review agencies; and

WHEREAS, Article 2.E. of the Palm Beach County Land Development Code authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to revoke the Development Order Amendment described in STR-2002-0052-1; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners incorporates by reference the Findings of Fact in the Status Report; and

WHEREAS, Article 2.A.1.K.3.b (Action by BCC) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the recommendation of Status Report No. STR-2002-0052-1, to revoke the Development Order Amendment previously granted by the approval of Zoning Application No. DOA/R-2008-00290, Control No. 2002-0052, confirmed by the adoption of Resolution R-2008-1709 on parcels of land legally described in EXHIBIT A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, and generally located as indicated on a vicinity sketch in EXHIBIT B, attached hereto and made a part hereof, is approved.
